The body responsible for cep is the non-profit-making Stiftung Ordnungspolitik. The principles of a free, market-based system form the theoretical foundation of our work. We stand for:

- ▶ Solid **structures upholding** democracy, **freedom and the rule of law** in Europe.
- ▶ **Completion of the internal market**
 - ▶ with no regulatory barriers at the internal borders and
 - ▶ with free competition promoting efficiency throughout the EU.
- ▶ **Appropriate distribution of powers** in accordance with the principle of subsidiarity.
- ▶ **Minimising regulation** and bureaucracy in the EU.

Centres for European Policy Network

The Centre de Politique Européenne was founded in 2019 as a non-profit foundation fund (fonds de dotation) with headquarters in Paris and French employees, in 2020 the Centro Politiche Europee was founded with headquarters in Rome. The Centres for European Policy Network want to contribute to a better mutual understanding of the often very different interests of the three countries and to develop market-based solutions capable of achieving a consensus.

Partner institutes in other European countries are being planned.
